2024 NCPPA TRAINING INSTITUTE “EMBRACING OUR PATH FORWARD”

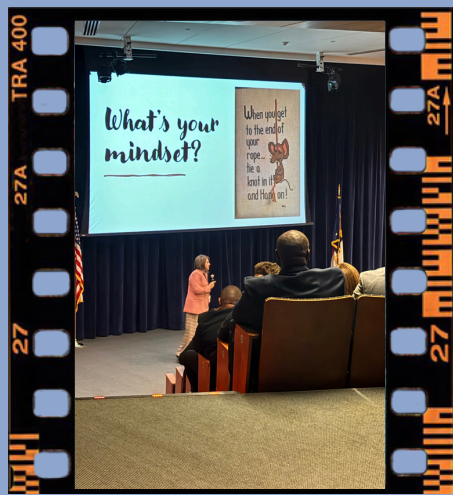
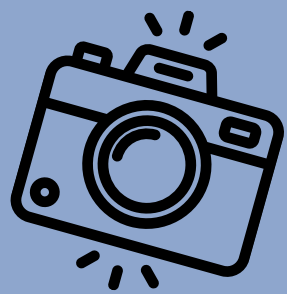

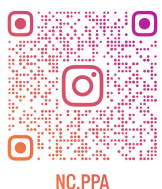


Winter Sparkle Celebration

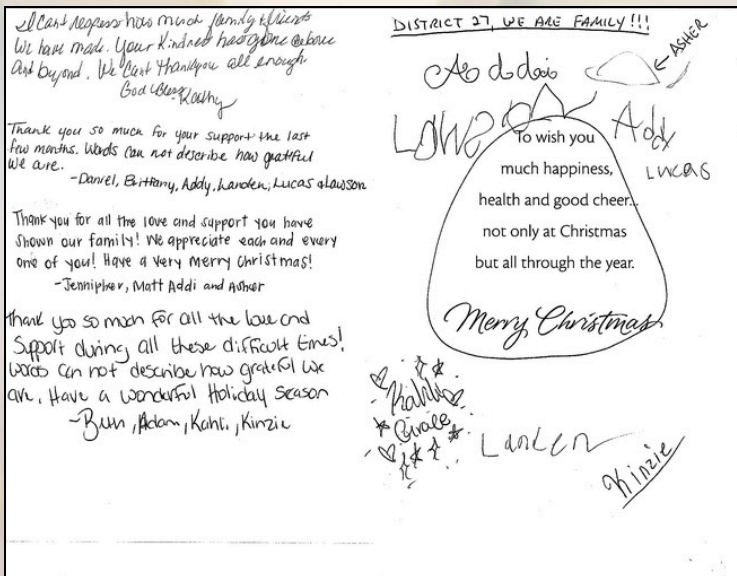
